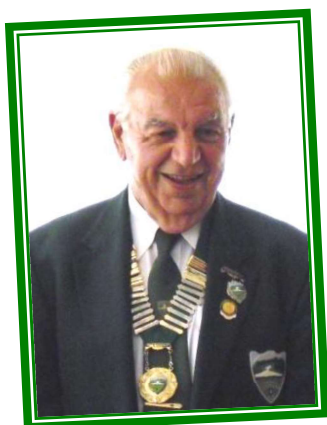


“Thank you very much!” to four stalwarts who have made huge contributions to the wellbeing of our club.
